Using GRE Scores

- This report of scores is valid only if received directly from ETS.
- GRE scores are confidential and should not be released by the recipient without the explicit permission of the test taker. All staff with access to score records should be explicitly advised of their confidential nature.
- The *GRE® Guide to the Use of Scores*, available at **www.ets.org/gre/guide**, contains guidelines describing both the appropriate uses of GRE scores and the limitations of their use. The Guide also contains information about GRE test content, scoring, interpretive information, statistical information, and Analytical Writing score level descriptions that describe the overall quality of critical thinking and analytical writing demonstrated across both tasks.

GRE General Test

- Tests taken prior to September 22, 2023, are just under 4 hours in length. Tests taken beginning on September 22, 2023, are just under 2 hours in length. Visit **www.ets.org/gre** to learn more.
- Verbal Reasoning and Quantitative Reasoning scores are reported on a 130–170 score scale, in one-point increments. Analytical Writing scores are reported on a 0–6 score scale, in half-point increments.

GRE Subject Tests

- Beginning in September 2023, the GRE Subject Tests will be administered on computer. The tests can be taken at test centers worldwide and at home in most countries. In addition, the test length and testing time for the Physics and Psychology Tests have been shortened. The test length and testing time for the Mathematics Test have not changed.
- Total scaled scores are reported on a 200–990 score scale, in 10-point increments.
- Scaled subscores on the Physics and Psychology Tests earned prior to September 2023 are reported on a 20–99 score scale, in one-point increments.
- Percent correct subscores earned on the Physics and Psychology Tests beginning in September 2023 will be reported on a 0–100 score scale, in one-point increments; these subscores should not be compared with scaled subscores earned prior to September 2023.
- Additional Subject Test information, including how subscores should be used, is available in the GRE® Guide to the Use of Scores.

Percentile Rank (% Below)

A percentile rank for a score indicates the percentage of test takers who took that test and received a lower score. Percentile ranks are updated annually. Regardless of when the reported scores were earned, the percentile ranks for GRE General Test and GRE Subject Test scores are based on the scores of all test takers who tested within a recent time period.
